CRYC's new fuel system is ready for you to use!

CRYC members can once again fuel up at CRYC's fuel dock and enjoy the 2025 boating season! It is a great club amenity, convenient, and offers cost savings for members. It's ready for you!

Note: The club is switching to premium non-ethanol gasoline (91 octane) after we use up the 4,000 gallons of regular non-ethanol (87 octane) currently in the new gasoline tank.

The new fuel system contractor, Peak Environmental of Vancouver, Washington, has finished all the work. Two new tanks—12,000 gallons each (one diesel and one gasoline), the previous gasoline tank was only 4,000 gallons. All new fuel lines and pulling conduit. Junctions, valving, etc. Testing is complete, and everything is approved, completed, warranted, and insured for the next 30 years. Thank you, Peak, for delivering high-quality work on budget and ahead of schedule.

Also, thank you to the many members who helped with the project, including the strong membership vote to fund it!

When you pull up to the fuel dock, you are not likely to notice anything different. The pumps and activating systems are still the same—use your same codes. The work done was all "upstream" of the dock.

The diesel and gasoline products are currently both the same as before: the diesel is #2 diesel for off-road use with a fuel additive, and the gasoline is presently midgrade (87 octane) non-ethanol. It is the "system" that is new, although all the fuel is "fresh."

The Club has decided to switch from non-ethanol "midgrade" (87 octane) gasoline to non-ethanol "premium" (91 octane). It appears premium will cost about 10–15 cents per gallon more than the mid-grade gasoline. The additional octane/performance difference should be valuable for the newer, larger gasoline engines. It should also help those of us with smaller gasoline engines on our tenders. It should not harm any gasoline engines.

Now would be a good time to review CRYC's "fueling" instructions on page 186 of the "just released" 2025 Club Roster. Also, refresh your boat's fueling procedures. Be safe! Remember, the fuel dock also has ice and wastewater pump-out.

Fuel up safely and have a great 2025 boating season.



Before Getting Fuel

- 1. If you do not have a fuel account, fill out a "New Fuel Account" form.
- 2. Provide vessel insurance to the Club office.
- 3. Once these are received, please allow 1-3 business days for the office to set up your fuel account.
- 4. You will receive an email confirming your account number and fuel pin. Please watch the instructional video that is included on how to pump fuel at the dock.

<u>At the Fuel Dock</u>

- The pump is open 24-7, 365 days of the year.
- There are environmental clean up pads available for \$1 ea. for small spills
- How to use the pump:
 - $\circ~$ At the terminal enter your four digit member number & press ENTER.
 - $\circ~$ When prompted, enter your four digit PIN and press ENTER.
 - Press 1 for Diesel and 2 for Gas, followed by ENTER.
 - WAIT 30 SECONDS PRIOR TO PUMPING FUEL!

Paying for Fuel

- Fuel is automatically charged to the credit card on file within 1-3 business days.
- You can receive a 3% discount on your purchase by paying with a check.
 Notify the office the day that you pump fuel that you would like to pay with a check. You will then have 3 business days to remit payment.

BOARD MINUTES OVERVIEW May 15th, 2025

The full meeting minutes can be found in the link tree.

Commodore Lance called the meeting to order. Approximately 15 members attended either in person or virtually. All board members were in attendance or provided a proxy.

STANDARD REPORTS:

- □ The April Board minutes were approved.
- □ The March financial report was presented, and the April financial report will be presented in June. The March financial report was approved.
- □ Commodore Kirk presented a brief report on a recent WOO meeting and summarized measures being taken to allow the Paddlefish to be used this cruise season.
- Vice Commodore Sutherland reported on the completion of the fuel system replacement and on going testing. The project appears to be on schedule and on budget, and the contractor did a very good job.
- □ Mr. Spargo reported on numerous operational matters.

ACTION ITEMS:

- □ A recommendation to contract for a new POS system was presented and discussed. A motion to approve the new POS system and the cost thereof was unanimously approved.
- □ The \$1,000 application fee for social memberships was extended through November 2025.
- Membership Committee Chair Francisco Rivera recommended to the board that Jane Cook, Bob Long, and Janice Sheaffer's resignations and Arnold Schuldt's demit be approved. These recommendations were duly moved, seconded, and approved unanimously.
- Moorage Chair Matt McCuddy recommended to the board that the sale and transfer of the water rights to slip D-19 from Kelli Watson-Brown to Paul Donahue be approved. The motion was approved unanimously.
- An additional \$5,200 to cover an overrun cost for concrete work and other improvements out to the peninsula was discussed. A motion to approve the additional amount was unanimously approved.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned by the Commodore. The next board meeting will be held on June 19, 2025.
